

Assabet River National Wildlife Refuge

Former Fort Devens Annex

2200 acres in towns of Sudbury, Maynard, Stow & Hudson
Opened to the public in March 2005.

Walk starts at 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, September 22, 2009
Meet at Refuge entrance on Hudson Road in Sudbury
located 2.5 miles west of Historic Sudbury Center.

From Sudbury center go a short distance west on Rt. 27
then continue straight west on Hudson Road.

Do not follow Rt. 27 north to Maynard.

On Hudson Road go 1 mile beyond Fairbank Rd.
but not as far as the Mass. Fire Academy.

Last time RMA visited ARNWR was Oct. and Nov. 2005

The walk will be easy since the terrain is fairly flat. Distance options from 2.0 to 3.5 miles.

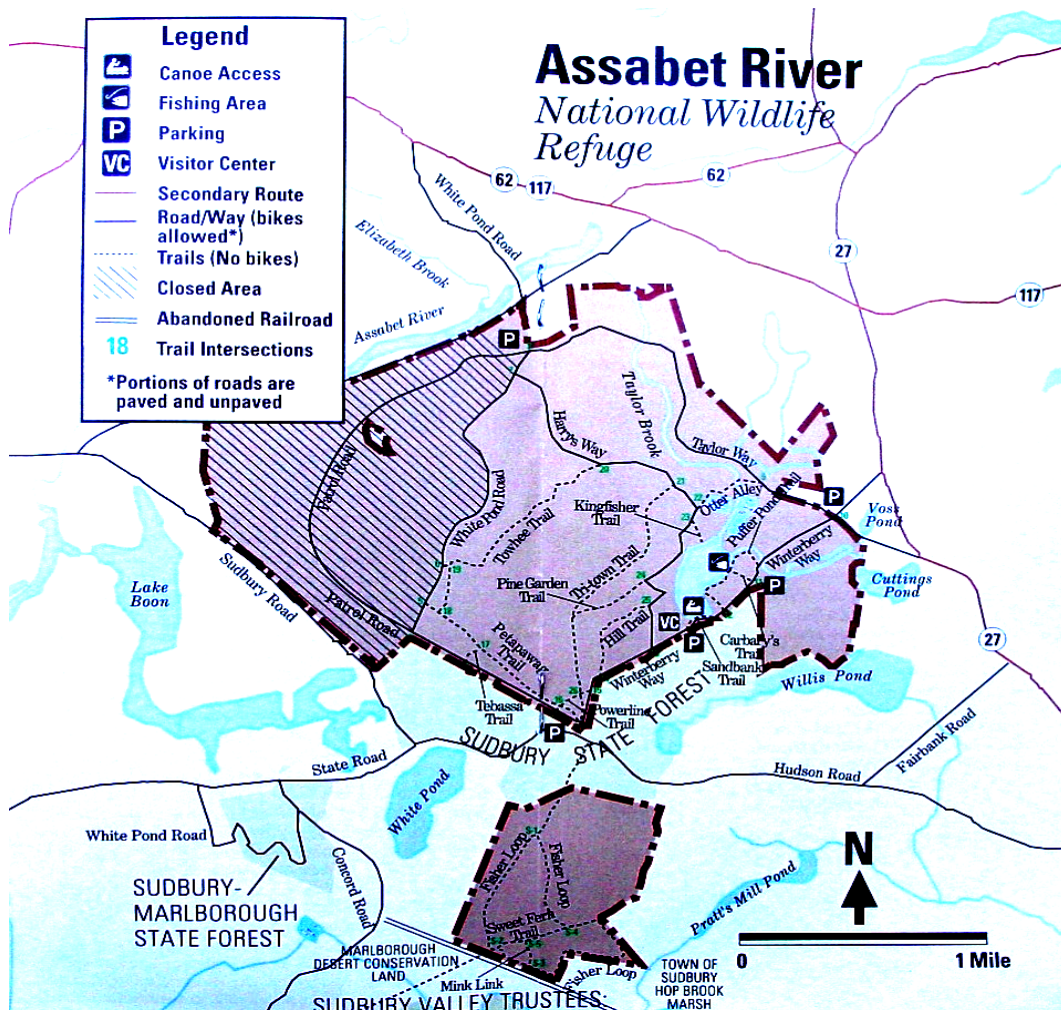
