We will take a 3 mile round trip walk along the Charles River in the Waltham/Watertown area taking a pathway up one side and returning on the other side.

We measured 8 miles from Wayland Center to SS&S. Take Rt. 20 through Waltham center, then south one block on Elm St. or Newton St. to east on River St. Go past Shaws and turn into SS&S. Plenty of parking.

This is one segment of a continuous pathway just completed and extending from Norembege Park, near 128 in Newton, to the Museum of Science in Boston! We may do other segments in the future. Join us as we explore the Charles River.
