*“A moderately easy ramble through woodland, meadow and wetlands habitats, offering a corresponding variety of flora and fauna, including lady slippers and blackberries, turtles and snakes sunning themselves, and great blue herons fishing or gliding overhead. Occasional briefly steep sections.”*

## **Directions: Simple!**

**Route 117 west through Stow. Harvard Road north to boat ramp.**

**Details: Take your best route to lights at Junction of Rt. 27 & Rt. 117 in Maynard.**

**Go west 3.1 mi. on Rt. 117 to Stow Center (west of shopping area).**

**Continue on Rt. 117 west 0.9 mi. Turn right onto Harvard Rd. Sign ‘Viewing area’**

**Go 1.8 mi. on Harvard Rd. to Boat Ramp on left just beyond a Country Club.**

**Plenty of good parking at the boat ramp access point.**
