

Great Meadows/SVT/LMCL Walk

Start at National Wildlife Refuge - Sudbury Unit

Thursday, October 29, 2009

Meet 10:00 AM at Refuge Visitors Parking Lot

One-hour-plus walk at a leisurely pace around a loop through woods, fields and to the top of Round Hill returning to the parking lot.

Views of fields and foliage should be excellent at this time of year.

Rating: Open trails and some minor elevation . Optional lunch.

We will meet at the visitor's parking lot of the Sudbury Division of the Great Meadows National Wildlife Refuge located off of Lincoln Road in Sudbury.

Directions:

From Sudbury Historic Center at Rt. 27 and Concord Rd. go NORTH 1 mile on Concord road to RIGHT onto Lincoln Rd. at the Lincoln/Sudbury High School.

EAST on Lincoln road about 1.3 miles to LEFT onto **Weir Hill Rd.**

From Wayland Center Rt. 126 NORTH about 2.5 miles to LEFT onto Sherman Bridge Rd.

WEST 1.5 miles crossing Sherman Bridge into Sudbury's Lincoln Rd. & RIGHT onto **Weir Hill Rd.**

On **Weir Hill Rd.** NORTH a short distance to RIGHT at entrance to REFUGE (gated, open daytimes). Signs along the way to Great Meadows Refuge area. Meet at visitor's lot at end of driveway.
