**Start at 10:00 AM at Codman Pool Parking Lot**

**Walk from Lincoln Schools through Lincoln Conservation land to the Codman Estate with its attractive gardens and grounds, and then through a wooded area and a garden farm ending at Route 117.**

**About 3 miles on dirt trails. Mostly flat terrain.**

**Rating: Easy walking. About 1&1/2 hours. Optional lunch.**

Directions: From intersection Rt. 126 & Rt. 117, east 0.5 miles on Rt. 117. Left on Lincoln Rd. 1.4 miles to Ballfield Rd. entrance to the Lincoln Schools on left. On Ballfield Road bear right to Codman Pool parking lot in northeast corner next to Brooks School.

From Rt. 128 take Trapelo Rd. exit towards Lincoln. At stop sign where Trapelo Rd. ends, left on Lincoln Rd. 0.6 miles to Ballfield Rd. Turn right to Codman Pool parking lot as described above.
