

Prospect Hill Park

314 Totten pond Road, Waltham, MA

Tuesday, June 19, 2007

Meet at base parking lot at 10:00 AM

We will then drive by car pool to an upper elevation parking area where trails (novice level) are located.

On the upper ridges of Prospect Hill we will follow the recommended “moderate gradient trails” in a loop and conclude with an excellent view of the Boston Skyline.

You may wish to come at least 15 minutes before we start to go to the nearby visitor’s center and pick up a Trail Map and Information.

Directions: The Park entrance is on Totten Pond Road at Park Headquarters about ½ mile east toward Waltham from the Rt. 128/95 Winter St./Totten Pond interchange 27.

A first traffic light services the interchange ramps. Go east past the Hilton and just beyond a second traffic light on Totten Pond road on the right is the Park Sign with a large parking area adjacent to the street **where we will meet**. Behind this lot are more parking and the visitor’s center and the access road to the upper parts of the park.
